All applicants are asked to complete the following questionnaire and turn it in to their guidance counselor before April 18, 2012. All high schools in Susquehanna County are included in this program.

1. Complete all sections of this form.
2. Provide a copy of a high school grade transcript (in a sealed envelope). Include class rank and class size.
3. Include two letters from people in authority who can attest to your character, integrity, ability, work habits and potential. Specific examples would be appreciated. The letters cannot be from a family member. Include the person's position and phone number.
4. Enclose proof of United States citizenship such as a copy of your birth certificate, naturalization papers, or information page from your passport.
5. A brief formal interview may be requested and would be held at the school of the applicant finalist.

Please type all information and submit it in a sealed envelope to your school counselor. Applications should be enclosed in the order listed above. Any essay exceeding 500 words will be disqualified. Please make sure you follow directions closely.
